### DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES / RESPONSIBILITIES

The Unit Training NCO accomplishes the day-to-day training and mobilization related functions in order to enhance the unit's training and mobilization readiness status. The Unit Training NCO is responsible to the unit commander for accomplishing the commander's plans and programs to attain the unit's training and mobilization readiness objectives. Drafts training schedules, and other training related correspondence in accordance with directives and publications of higher headquarters. Responsible for keeping the unit commander advised on current unit readiness and mobilization requirements and / or status. Assist the unit commander in developing and maintaining the unit's mobilization plan. Prepare training charts, schematics, graphs, etc., for use during briefings and or training. Prepares and submits the unit's MOS qualification status reports, unit status reports, and any other training related reports required by higher Headquarters. Monitors individual training and maintains individual and unit training records. Perform other duties as assigned.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

ELIGIBILITY: Anyone may apply for this position. If not currently in an AGR status, to qualify for appointment individuals MUST MEET ALL initial eligibility requirements of AR 135-18 and NGR 600-5:

- a. Must be or become a member of the TENNESSEE Army National Guard prior to entering the AGR program
- b. Must be able to serve a minimum of three (3) years in an active duty status prior to completing 18 years of Active Federal Service (AFS) or reach Mandatory Removal Date (MRD) whichever is earlier.
- c. Must meet medical standards prescribed in Chapter 3 of AR 40-501.
- d. Must meet physical standards prescribed in AR 600-9.
- e. Must have sufficient time remaining on current enlistment to complete an initial (3) year tour.
- f. Must Not be entitled to Military Retired Pay. (Waived by The Secretary of the Army)
- g. Must Not be a candidate for or holding an elected Civil office or engaged in partisan political activities.
- h. Must Not be under a current Suspension of Favorable Personnel Actions (flag).
- i. Must Not have resigned from the AGR program or other military service in lieu of adverse action.
- j. Must Not have been separated from the AGR program or other military service for cause, unsuitability or unfitness.
- k. Individuals not selected for continuation in the AGR program are ineligible for selection.
- l. Must supply certificate in proof of an awarded MOS if the MOS is not listed on DA Form 2-1/ ERB / ORB.

  - c. DD Form 2807-1 and DD Form 2808 (w/in five years) or MEDPROS, Individual Medical Record (IMR) or annual Physical Health Assessment (PHA).
  - d. Photograph in Class A Uniform, ACU or ASU's
  - e. Last 5 NCOERs or OERs (whichever is applicable)
  - f. DA Form 705 (latest APFT Card)
  - g. DD Form(s) 214 and NGB Form(s) 23 (all periods of active duty)
  - h. Announcement Number at the top of page on NGB Form 34-1
  - i. TN Form 0345 (current weight cert) AND if applicable, DA Form 5500 / 5501 (Body Fat Content Worksheet)
