DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES / RESPONSIBILITIES

The unit supply specialist supervises or performs duties involving request, receipt, storage, issue, accountability and preservation of individual, organizational, installation and expendable supplies and equipment. Provide guidance to lower grade personnel. Directs supply personnel in establishing supply and inventory control management functions. Maintain property under standard property book system (SPBS). Review daily and monthly records of issues of petroleum products and operating supplies. Provide technical assistance to equipment records and parts specialist. Assists and advises supply officer and commander. No documented instances in the last 5 years of conduct which reflects adversely on the character, honesty, or integrity of the soldier. No other record of disciplinary action under UCMJ or pattern of behavior which indicates a lack of integrity or which is inconsistent with the 92Y position of trust. No conviction or other adverse disposition for criminal offenses listed as a misdemeanor or felony as outlined AR 601-210, chapter 4. This criteria is not waivable.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

ELIGIBILITY: Anyone may apply for this position. If not currently in an AGR status, to qualify for appointment individuals MUST MEET ALL initial eligibility requirements of AR 135-18 and NGR 600-5:

- Must be or become a member of the TENNESSEE Army National Guard prior to entering the AGR program
- Must be able to serve a minimum of three (3) years in an active duty status prior to completing 18 years of Active Federal Service (AFS) or reach Mandatory Removal Date (MRD) whichever is earlier.
- Must meet medical standards prescribed in Chapter 3 of AR 40-501.
- Must meet physical standards prescribed in AR 600-9.
- Must have sufficient time remaining on current enlistment to complete an initial (3) year tour.
- Must Not be entitled to Military Retired Pay. (Waived by The Secretary of the Army)
- Must Not be a candidate for or holding an elected Civil office or engaged in partisan political activities.
- Must Not be under a current Suspension of Favorable Personnel Actions (flag).
- Must Not have resigned from the AGR program or other military service in lieu of adverse action.
- Must Not have been separated from the AGR program or other military service for cause, unsuitability or unfitness.
- Individuals not selected for continuation in the AGR program are ineligible for selection.
- Must supply certificate in proof of an awarded MOS if the MOS is not listed on DA Form 2-1/ ERB / ORB.

- (a) A minimum score of 90 in aptitude area CL in Armed Services Vocational aptitude Battery (ASVAB) tests administered prior to 2 January 2002.
- (b) A minimum score of 88 in aptitude area CL on ASVAB tests administered on and after 2 January 2002 and prior to 1 July 2004.
- (c) A minimum score of 86 in aptitude area CL and 85 in aptitude area OF on ASVAB tests administered on and after 1 July 2004.

Individual(s) selected will be ordered to Full-Time Duty (State) status under the authority of Title 32 USC, Section 502 (f).

- b. ERB or ORB (*ASVAB scores must be included in order to be considered for enlisted positions only*)
- c. DD Form 2807-1 and DD Form 2808 (w/in five years) or MEDPROS, Individual Medical Record (IMR) or annual Physical Health Assessment (PHA).
- d. Photograph in Class A Uniform, ACU or ASU's
- e. Last 5 NCOERs or OERs (whichever is applicable)
- f. DA Form 705 (latest APFT Card)
- g. DD Form(s) 214 and NGB Form(s) 23 (all periods of active duty)
- h. Announcement Number at the top of page on NGB Form 34-1
- i. TN Form 0345 (current weight cert) AND if applicable, DA Form 5500 / 5501 (Body Fat Content Worksheet)
